International symposium on "Soil Management and Potash Fertilizer Uses in West Asia and North Africa Region" Antalya, 22-25 November 2010

The International Potash Institute (IPI), in collaboration with Ege University organizes an international symposium in Antalya entitled "Soil Management and Potash Fertilizer Uses in West Asia and North Africa Region".

The WANA region is known for its exports of agricultural products, including fruits and vegetables, which provide important incomes. However, a large part of the production is used to feed the population, which is increasing in a huge way. Balanced fertilization and particularly the use of potash is generally not well known.

The sustainability of agricultural systems greatly depends on balanced fertilization to improve soil fertility for secure and sustainable food production. Potassium fertilizers play a crucial role in improving the quality and yields of crops and thus contribute to the welfare of farming communities. Many areas of the region are sandy soils or calcareous soils, leading easily to nutrient deficiencies. Water availability and high evaporation are other important parameters which affect productivity. The development of advanced technologies and fertilization practices is a priority to secure food production in the region, as well as a significant effort in education.

During the symposium, issues including soil fertility, quality of mineral fertilizers, efficient use of fertilizers, fertigation and foliar application will be discussed. This event will be of interest to soil and plant nutrition scientists, agronomists, and extension officers from universities and research organizations, government offices, agribusinesses and farmers who share an interest in improving food production and quality in the region. The organizers anticipate participation from across the region. Invited speakers will include scientists from the WANA region and from Europe,. The symposium will be announced at all universities in Turkey. Poster presentations are open to all, and students in the region are particularly encouraged to participate and present research related/relevant to the themes of the symposium.

Main themes

- Soil status in WANA region with an emphasis on potassium soil fertility
- o Agricultural development and the current fertilization practices in WANA region
- Improvement of soil fertility and responsible use of potash fertilizers to ensure advancement of food security
- Nutrient management with an emphasis on potassium to increase yield and quality of crops grown in the region
- Potassium and nitrogen interaction
- Use of potash fertilizers to improve water use efficiency
- Potassium and plant stress: salinity, drought, etc.
- o Potassium and application techniques: fertigation, foliar spray, etc
- Environmental benefits of Potassium on salinity control, drought tolerance, etc.
- Fertilization of crops to improve sustainability and farmers' income
- o Extension strategies to deliver knowledge to farmers
